FCMS Math Club participates in Math Olympiad, Math Madness, AMC 8/10/AIME, Math Counts, BCCTM, Math Con and Mu Alpha Theta competitions.
*Registration for Math Madness Competition will be completed individually using student email. After submitting this registration form with their email address, students will receive an email request to register and must register prior to the competition in order to participate. Students are responsible for keeping their username and password handy for the competitions as I will not have access to that. I strongly suggest each student use their own email to register and not a parent email. Please do not use the student.falconcove.net email as it is not compatible with Math Madness
Competition for Math Madness takes place at school.
*AMC 8 registration is held separately. Please complete and return the AMC 8 registration form prior to the deadline in order to participate. All Falcon Cove students who are 14.5 years your younger on the date of the competition are eligible to participate. Math Club Membership is not required for AMC 8. Students who score a minimum of 20 out of 25 points on the AMC 8 will be invited to participate in the AMC 10 A and B.
Competition for AMC Series are held on campus after school.
*Participation in the Math Counts county competition is limited to 10 students per school. The top 10 individual math club members based on ranking from Math Olympiad, Math Madness, and AMC 8 will be invited to attend. Students will be chosen in January.
County competition takes place on a Saturday. Students selected will be notified individually prior to the competition.
*Dates of upcoming competitions are posted on canvas and are subject to change (by competition companies). I will update Canvas and make announcements during club practice sessions if a date does change.
*Top 30 students will be posted outside of room 229 and will be updated periodically.
*Make-up competitions are not permitted for any competition per competition rules. If a student is not present for a competition, they will be marked absent and will not be eligible to earn points for that day.
*BCCTM participants are chosen based on club and class performance. The team of 4 will be chosen for each category $\left(6^{\text {th }}\right.$ grade advanced, $6^{\text {th }}$ grade Pre-Algebra, $7^{\text {th }}$ grade Pre-Algebra, $7^{\text {th }}$ grade Algebra, $8^{\text {th }}$ grade Algebra, $8^{\text {th }}$ grade Geometry, EMF 6, 7, 8).
BCCTM competition takes place on a Saturday. Students selected to participate will be notified prior to the competition.
*Mu Alpha Theta Competitions are for students enrolled in a High School Math Course only (Algebra, Geometry, etc.). A sign up form will be emailed home to all eligible students once Math Club registration ends for students to sign up for the contest(s) they plan on attending.
Mu Alpha Theta Competitions are held on Saturdays.
*MathCon is a new competition to Falcon Cove. Students will compete at their own grade level. The strongest students Nationwide are invited to participate in a MathCon Nationals competition in Chicago. More information will be provided throughout the year.
*Officers - An officer will be elected from each grade level. Students interested in running for office must email me their information prior to the election meeting and be prepared to speak to the group regarding their interest.
*Please listen to announcements for important information regarding upcoming practices, competitions, results, etc. Announcements will also be made through notifications in Canvas.
