To Request Transcripts

- · Log on to Clever
 - o http://sso.browardschools.com
 - Click on Naviance to access your account
- Click on the "Colleges"
- Click on "Colleges I'm Applying To"
- Click on to the right. (You will need to add the college that you're applying to if it isn't there already AND you must indicate how you are submitting your application.)
- Do not select <u>"I'm not sure yet"</u> or we will not be able to send your transcript.
- Click "I've submitted my application" (Only request transcripts if you have completed your college application)
- · Click on "Add and Request Transcript"
- Click on "What type of transcript are you requesting"
- Click on "Request and Finish"

Student Code of Conduct Discipline:


<u>1st Offense:</u> 1-2 days in-school suspension (Administrative Detentions) with required intervention assignments and a referral to the District Substance Abuse Case Manager.

2nd Offense: 6-day suspension with required intervention program assignments and a referral to the District Substance Abuse Case Manager.

<u>3rd and Subsequent Offenses:</u> 10-day suspension, recommendation for expulsion and a referral to the District Substance Abuse Case Manager.

Secondary students, (Grades 6-12): The student shall be regular school program for ten (10) days and expulsion shall be mandatory. The student shall be placed in the Expuision Abeyance Fregram for a period of one (1) calendar year commencing with the date of the offense, with Substance Workback. The expulsion shall be held in abeyance if the student completes the District approved or state-certified drug rehabilitation or treatment program with a certified addiction professional. The District substance abuse case manager shall monitor/verify that the student has completed the program. The student may return to a regular school program upon successful completion of the prescribed rehabilitation or treatment program.



Senior Package Rules

- You CAN purchase a Grad Day shirt or senior shirt if you don't want the whole senior package. They must be purchased during the first week of package sales. Will be available online. Senior shirts will only be available for purchase during this time.
- Grad Day will continue to be available WHILE SPACE REMAINS on the buses.
- All students who would like to ride a bus together should all sign up together. Once a student has been placed on a bus, bus assignments will **NOT** be changed. 32

 - If you are not on track to graduate as determined by administration, you will **NOT** be allowed to purchase a senior package. If you bring your GPA up and complete your requirements, you will be allowed to purchase activities separately, **IF THERE IS SPACE AVAILABLE.**
 - Excessive absences and/or tardiness may result in the loss of your senior privileges, and refunds will **NOT** be given.
