

Essential Updates for FTE

- Assess new students and update status
- Update PLAN dates for active ELLs (LY) to their first day of school
- Conduct Annual Reviews: Make recommendations for ELLs entering years 2 and 3 (Continue or Exit?)
- Conduct ELL Committee Meetings for Extension of Services (REEVALs) for ELLs entering years 4,
 5, 6, and beyond

Essential Updates on ELLevation

- ELL Plan must include accommodations for 20/21 SY, updated schedules, Program 130 and updated ELL Plan date. (LY)
- **Parent Letter** must be saved for LP (COVID-19), LY (Initial/Continuing) Exit (met criteria or exited during meeting)
- Meetings REEVALs signature page must be uploaded. If not completed within 30 days must use: Due to Covid19 and late return of ACCESS for ELLs data, the meeting was held after the October 1st date.



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LP Status (K-12)


ELL Status Code LP (Pending Assessment)

Based on the response(s) to the Home Language Survey (HLS), potential ELLs enrolled during COVID-19 will be coded LP (student is in grades K-12th, "yes" is marked for any of the 3 HLS questions, and is pending initial placement assessment).

Students who will need to be tested post COVID19.

IPT Placement Assessment Options



Continue coding LP; however we need to test students before October FTE for funding



Schedule students for in person testing following CDC guidelines **OR** attempt to administer virtually using TEAMS.



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



Virtual ELL Committee Meetings will be held frequently to assure that schools are identifying students requiring additional services.






