




LP Status (K-12)



REEVAL Extension: Request 1

Good Morning ESOL Contacts,

As previously discussed during our last ESOL Contact Meeting, BCPS requested from the state an extension for utilization of ACCESS scores for REEVALs. Our request to extend the use of ACCESS for ELLs scores until October 30th has been approved!

Reminder: DEUSS date is on or prior to October 30th

This letter is to request additional time for Broward County Public Schools (BCPS) to complete Extension of Services for students in the English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) Program per Rule 6A-6.09022, F.A.C.

Due to COVID-19, BCPS received final ACCESS for ELLs scores on September 14, 2020.

Request 1:

- Broward County Public Schools would like to request an extension to use ACCESS for ELLs scores to determine Extension of Services to Friday October 30, 2020 for the students below.
- As of October 2, 2020, the following number of students were still in need of Extension of Services ELL Committee Meetings to meet the October 1, 2020 deadline.
 - 4th year Extension of Services: 1047
 - 5th year Extension of Services: 1001
 - 6th year Extension of Services: 608

REEVAL Extension: Request 2

Upon return to a brick and mortar setting, BCPS has been approved an extension of 30-days (school days) to begin administering a current L/S/R/W assessment, and conduct an ELL Committee Meeting. The extension would begin the first day the student returns to a brick and mortar setting.

Request 2:

- BCPS students will have the option of returning to a brick and mortar setting beginning October 9, 2020
 in a staggered manner with all grade levels returning by October 20, 2020. Some students will remain in
 a virtual e-learning setting.
- Upon return to a brick and mortar setting, BCPS would like to request an extension of 30-days to begin
 administering a current L/S/R/W assessment and conduct an ELL Committee Meeting. The extension
 would begin the first day the student returns to a brick and mortar setting.
- As of October 2, 2020, the following number of students need Extension of Services ELL Committee Meetings after the October 1, 2020 deadline.
 - 4th year Extension of Services: 663
 - 5th year Extension of Services: 415
 - 6th year Extension of Services: 300

On October 9th, the **District updated the Tier Placement information based on criteria provided by the DOE**.

This school year, the District was unable to provide schools the opportunity to review / update the Tier due to the immediate focus on identification/testing of new ELL students.

SUBJECT: INTERNAL TRANSFER MORATORIUM LIFTED

ACTION: All students are eligible to resume transfers between district schools when their primary residential address changes beginning on Thursday, October 8, 2020.

RATIONALE: Previously, a September 8, 2000 memo created a moratorium on internal transfers until school campuses physically reopen. This moratorium is now lifted as students may begin returning to brida-and-mortar schools on Friday, October 9, 2020.

Students whose primary residential address has changed and choose to:

- Remain in the eLearning environment may continue enrollment in their current school or transfer to their new school.
- Attend in-person at the current brick-and-mortar school must complete a reassignment application to remain at that school. Eligibility to remain through the end of the current school year or through the highest grade level offered at the school will be determined based on the capacity of that school.






Accommodations and Instructional Practices for English Language Learners (ELLs) for Classroom Observation

An **approved glossary** is defined as **word-to-word** and may include **content specific** glossary.
















LF Process in ELLevation
