Supplement Not Supplant Provision for Title III of the ESEA
Section 3115(g) of Title III of the ESEA (hereafter "Title III") provides as follows:
SUPPLEMENT, NOT SUPPLANT Federal funds made available under this subpart shall be used so as to supplement the level of Federal, State, and local public funds that, in the absence of such availability, would have been expended for programs for limited English proficient children and immigrant children and youth and in no case to supplant such Federal, State, and local public funds.
In practice, the prohibition against supplanting under Title III means that recipients may not use hose funds to pay for services that, in the absence of Title III funds, would be necessary to be provided by other Federal, or State, or local funds.
**As a rule, services for students, including ELLs, mandated by Title I may not be paid for by Title III funds because Title III forbids supplanting of other federal funds in addition to forbidding hat Title III monies be used to fund activities that would have otherwise been funded through state and local funds. **
