## Sample Tasks for ESOL Paraprofessionals

Below are responsibilities that may be assigned to ESOL paraprofessionals. Note that these are suggestions--each school provides guidelines to paraprofessionals based on needs:

Tasks	Action Steps
Support of Student Learning	-Assist teachers with developing language goals for their ELLs -Provide assistance to teachers when planning for instruction to ensure differentiation of instruction and implementation of appropriate ELL strategies -Assist teachers in developing alternative assessments for ELLs to ensure comprehension of vocabulary, skills, and content -As needed, conduct data chats regarding ELLs
Support Instruction	-Utilize district approved curriculum platforms and tools -Provide support to teachers building their own lessons to ensure differentiation of instruction and implementation of appropriate ELL strategies -Assist teachers by developing adapting district created lessons in Canvas -Connect daily with individual or groups of teachers via Microsoft Teams or telephone -Conduct virtual PLCs
Support Families of ELLs	-Assisting teachers with troubleshooting technology questions by students and families -Provide translation of instructions on teacher developed lessonsClarify difficult concepts or content by providing supplemental resource linkages, developing video shorts, etcSupporting school sites by assisting with the distribution of technology resourcesCoordinate with your site administrator to assist with home language communications
