

#### Four Additional Food Distribution Sites Open on Monday, April 6








### LY Missing Accommodations View



### ACCESS for ELLs

Dear ESOL Contact/ACCESS for ELLs Testing Coordinator:

Student Assessment and Research (SAR) has sent your principal the attached directions for ACCESS for ELLs and FSAA testing materials. *Please direct all questions/comments/concerns to your school leadership team.* 

All ACCESS for ELLs testing materials need to be packed and secured by tomorrow, Friday, April 3, 2020.

Although the actual pick up date is unknown at this time, materials must be packed and secured.

Packing Instructions to be completed by April 3, 2020:

- . All secure test materials must be kept secure in locked storage until school buildings are re-opened to all staff.
- . SAR will notify schools when it is time to return these materials.
- . ACCESS for ELLs and FSAA test materials must be packed in separate boxes.

#### **ACCESS Testing Materials Directions**

- 1. Pack all ACCESS for ELLs test materials together in boxes. To-Be-Scored and Not-To- Be-Scored test materials may be packed together in the same boxes
- 2. Seal the boxes with packing tape and number the boxes, 1 of n, 2 of n, etc., where "n" is the total number of ACCESS for ELLs boxes.
- 3. Do not place a return label on the box. SAR will label the boxes once we receive them.
- 4. Place all ACCESS for ELLs boxes in locked storage





#### Notification of Initial English Language Program Placement

Student: Ella Vation School: Croffon Elementary

Grade Level: 6 ESOL Status: LP (Pending Assessment)

Our school district provides a program of language instruction for English Language Learners (ESOLs) to attain English proficiency, and meet the same challenging academic content and student achievement standards exceeded of all students.

Upon enrollment, a language other than English was noted on your child's Home Language Survey. According to state and federal law, our school district is required to assess the English language proficiency of your child in listening, speaking, reading, and writing. Based on the results of the, a state-approved assessment for measuring English language proficiency, we are pleased to inform you that your child is eligible for services for English Language Learners, Below, please find results that have informed our decision, information about our language programs, and your rights as a parent.

Additional factors used to determine your child's program eligibility: Child is temporarily receiving services and currently does not have scores due to COVID19.

Teachers of English Language Learners provide a variety of specialized services until students demonstrate skills in English sufficient for them to succeed academically in the regular classroom. While the rate of English language development (ELD) varies between students, many exit the ELD program in 2-6 years. Your child's English language development will be assessed annually until heiste achieves: a ELP score of at least Proteint on the assessment when school returns, and meets specific academic achievement requirements. Students who exit the program are monitored for academic success for 2 years.

All children, regardless of English proficiency, are eligible to participate in all school-wide programs. If your child has an individualized Education Plan (IEP), or a 504 plan, the language instruction educational program will be utilized in coordination with your child's existing plan.

As a parent, you have the right to decline enrollment in a program or type of service, withdraw your child from the program at any time, or choose another program if available. If you have any questions about your child's placement or the type of program options available to you, please contact Broward County at 999-111-5555.

This letter informs you of certain rights you have as a parent or guardian. Contact your school administrator if you have specific questions concerning these rights.

#### K-12 Program Services for English Language Learners

Our school district provides English language instruction within the context of academic content – using grade-level curriculum – to students at all levels of English language proficiency (ELP) by offering the following programs:

#### E - Sheltered English

Shellered English Instruction (SEI): This program provides nearly all classroom instruction in English with curriculum and instruction designed for English learners. English learners receive instruction to account the accademic English they need to meet grade-level content standards.

#### I - Mainstream/inclusion - English

Requiar English instruction: Students are instructed in English at all times, native language is not used. The instructional goal is to meet grade appropriate academic achievement standards for grade promotion and graduation.

#### O - Maintenance or Developmental Bilingual Education

Maintenance Developmental Billingual Education (MBEDBE): MBE, also referred to as late-exit billingual education, is a program that uses two languages, the students primary language and English, as a means of instruction. The instruction budies upon the students primary language skills and develops and expands the English language skills of each student to enable him or her to achieve profidency in both languages, while providing access to the content areas.

#### T - Dual Language (Two-Way Developmental Billingual Education)

Dual Language Two-Way Immersion Program: A bi-Hieracy program that integrates students who are proficient in English and identified ELL students in both English and another language. Instruction is provided to both native English speakers and native speakers of another language in an instructional setting where language learning is integrated with content instruction. Academic subjects are student to all sudemis strowords both English and before language.

#### Title III - Tutoring

English Language Tutoring (ELT): One-on-one or small group tutoring/assistance to ELLs outside of school hours, concentrated on accelerating English language proficiency






