OBLIGATIONS!!

- Students may choose to bring in your obligation items prior.

Stadium's Clear Bag Policy

Applies to Grads & Guests.

Clear Bag Policy

To provide a safer environment for the public and expedite guest entry into the stadium, Drive Pink Stadium policy limits and restricts the size and type of bags that are permitted into the stadium during any events taking place at Drive Pink Stadium.

We encourage guests not to bring any bags, however, the following will be permitted:

- One clear bag no larger than 14"x14"x6".
- Guests may carry a small clutch bag or purse no larger than 6.5"x6.5" (approximately the size of a hand) with or without a strap.
- Each ticket holder, including children, may carry an approved clear bag and a clutch purse.
- Diapers and wipes may be carried in a clear bag. However, diaper bags are not permitted.
- Additional clothing, ponchos, etc. are permitted if carried loosely or in an approved clear bag.
- Large purses, coolers, briefcases, backpacks, luggage of any kind, computers/laptops bags,
 camera bags or any bag larger than the permissible size as described above will not be allowed.
- Exceptions will be made for medically necessary items after proper inspection and documentation.

There are no provisions to check items at the gates. Guests will be asked to either take prohibited items back to their car or dispose of prohibited items at the gate. DRV PNK Stadium and its affiliates are not responsible for items left behind, lost, stolen, or damaged.

Graduate Decorum

- Signed and submitted <u>BCPS</u>
 <u>Decorum Letter</u> required
- Available on Senior Canvas page
- Hard copies available in Main Office
- Must be submitted prior to cap/gown pick-up.

Graduate Dress Code

- Herff Jones rented Cap & Gown only.
- No other cap/gown/mask may be worn.
- WBH cap/gowns are SILVER. Mask is black.
- If you come to graduation and your gown is not from HJ, you will be given and charged for the HJ gown at the stadium.

Class of 2021 Graduate Mask and Cap

- May be decorated in accordance with SBBC Mask Policy
- May not contain messages or graphics that are suggestive, indecent, associated with drugs, violence, ... or affiliated with a political party and/or message.

WBH Graduation Dress Code

Graduate Dress Code:

- Cap & gown rented from Herff Jones.
- WBH mask and cap for every graduate are provided to every graduate as part of the commencement ceremony, to keep.
- Graduate dress code rules for all graduates:
 - No jeans.
 - No shorts (gentlemen).
 - Sensible shoes for safety when walking the turf sidelines.





Assigned Seating at Graduation

- You will get your seating assignment with your tickets at Senior Check-out.
 - Take a photo of it!!
- Check in at the entry of the stadium, under the bleachers upon arrival, if you lose your seating card.
- Proceed to your seat assignment.
 - Keep this card with you at ALL times.
- Robed faculty members will assist you along the way.
- Your seat assignment will be designated by:
 - Row "Letter"
 - Seat "Number"





Walking across the stage ... Part 1: The Grad Walk

- You will be directed by a gowned faculty member to stand when it is time for your row to exit the stands and walk to the stage.
- When you go under the stands, you will pick up your diploma cover and take your first of two graduate photos.
- You will then be guided to exit from under the stands and head towards the stage.
- On the stage, you will take your second of two photos, this one standing next to Principal Fatout.
 - Although there are many people on the stage who will want to congratulate you, CDC Guidelines direct us to avoid hand-shaking and hugging.

 - Your mask must stay on the entire time, unless directed otherwise on the day of the event.



Strut your stuff ... Part 2: The Journey

- When you exit the stage, you will walk along the sideline the length of the field.
- At the end of the field, you will walk across the endzone to the stands where to your assigned seat.
- Please! Wear sensible shoes! You will be walking the length of the soccer field and then across the end zone all on the turf! This is not something that should be done with heeled shoes!
- Upon returning to your seat, enjoy the view! Be mindful of the moment. You are no longer a senior. You will now officially be a West Broward High Graduate!

Pro Tips...

- Pay your obligations before May 31st!
 - Online through the eStore or in person on campus, EXACT CASH ONLY.
- Plan time for parking and the walk to the arena.
- Don't be late!
- Take your pictures BEFORE the Ceremony!
 - You will not have your gown after the ceremony.
- 2 tickets per Grad! Grads do not need a ticket.
- Wear sensible shoes! You will be walking around the entire soccer field!
- Check list:
 - Cap, Gown, Tassel, Cords, and approved Mask!
 - Appropriate behavior during the ENTIRE ceremony! This includes your families as well!
 - You will get your graduation medallion at check-in.

RECAP ...

Check Virtual Counselor and clear your obligations as soon as possible.

- Graduation Decorum Letter Signed and Submitted. Required by day of cap/gown distribution. Available on Senior Canvas page.
- Each Graduate will receive 2 tickets for graduation. These tickets are free to each graduate walking in the ceremony.

- If you have the item, bring it back to campus when possible, prior to/or on your cap/gown distribution day.
 - Make sure your name is on everything you return to campus!
- If you do not have the item, obligations may be paid in the following ways:
 - Via the eStore.
 - On campus with cash, exact amount required (no checks).
- Protocols for Graduates to follow for participation and decorum.
- Dress code for Commencement Ceremony:
 - Herff Jones Cap & Gown; WBH-issued mask
 - Cap and Mask are yours to keep and may be decorated in accordance with SBBC Policy.
 - Dress code no jeans, no shorts (gentlemen), sensible shoes for safety.
- The Graduate does not need a ticket.
- Every person entering the stadium must have a ticket; this includes small children.
- Guests and Graduates enter through different gates.
- WBH does not have extra tickets to offer.
- Guests are to social distance themselves on the east side of the stadium.
