Dual Enrollment





Take college courses that count as both high school credit and college credit



Become part of your Official College Transcript; Start College GPA!

EARLY ADMISSION

- Early Admission, a form of dual enrollment, allows eligible high school senior students to enroll full-time at BC.
- Students must enroll in at least 12 credits per term (fulltime student)
- Must maintain a college GPA of 2.0 or greater and unweighted high school GPA of 3.0 or greater
- Have graduation requirements met
- Still an MSD student who can participate in activities like homecoming, grab bash, prom, graduation
