- Additional Quality Point(s)
- All Courses are factored in
- Honors (+1) Advanced Placement (+2), and Dual Enrollment (+2)

- Used for class rank

Unweighted

- All Courses are factored in
- No Additional Quality Point
- Out of scale of unweighted 4.0 GPA
- GPA Needed for Graduation

EARLY ADMISSION

- Early Admission, a form of dual enrollment, allows eligible high school senior students to enroll full-time at BC.
- Students must enroll in at least 12 credits per term (full-time student)
- Must maintain a college GPA of 2.0 or greater and unweighted high school GPA of 3.0 or greater
- Have graduation requirements met
- Still an MSD student who can participate in activities like homecoming, grab bash, prom, graduation

 - Scoring is out of 1600
 - *800 Section – Math
 - *800 Section – Reading & English
- Offers more time per question

- 4 Sections:
 - 1 Reading
 - 1 English/Grammar
 - 1 Science Reasoning
 - 1 Math (with calculator)
 - Essay / Writing is Optional
 - Scoring is out of 36
 - *Each Section out of 36
