Student Guide: How to Access the Dual Enrollment Recommendation Form

***You must know your BC ID Number, BC Email Address, and BC User ID**

***Use and Check your BC Email Address** (you will receive an email after each person has completed and approved your form)

****FALL 2021 DUE BY APRIL 22, 2021*** (Both Student & Parent Portion Due by April 22nd)

Step 1: Confirm with your school counselor that you meet the eligibility requirements: 3.0 or higher Unweighted GPA and College Ready Test Scores: either in the form of PERT, SAT, ACT, or ACCUPLACER.

Note: If you need to take a Common Placement Test, you will need to:

▪ **Process for Student Testing:**

- 1) Student applies to BC online (See Step 2)
- 2) Student notifies School Counselor they wish to test
- 3) MSD notifies the Dual Enrollment Department
- 4) Testing Center sends voucher/link to student via BC Email (5-7 days) for remote testing. Check email for voucher. *(This is subject to change when the Testing Center reopens at the College.)*
- 5) Student takes test and downloads scores in PDF to send to counselor

Step 3: Dual Enrollment Recommendation Form

- Log into your BC One Access account- using your BC User ID and Password. You will need to know your security answers, as well.
- Click on “Complete This Form” – Dynamic Forms
- Complete the entire student portion.** *(Make sure all your information looks good. You cannot go back and change your form once you submit it)*

Attendance/Drop/Withdrawal Requirements

It is the student's responsibility to attend all classes in which he/she is enrolled. Students who wish to drop or withdraw from a course are responsible for completing this process online or at a BC admissions office by the published deadline dates on the academic calendar by session. Students must notify their school counselor if they choose to drop or withdraw from a course. Each faculty member is required to report non-attendance through the enrollment verification period which will result in a grade of WN on a student's transcript.

Step 4: Parent Part

*Your form will be routed to your parent/legal guardian for approval.

Parent Steps Below:

- 1) Receives email from forms@broward.edu (check Spam folder, also)
- 2) Login to sign form (1st time users need to set up account)
- 3) Sign form and Submit Form. Once Parent submits, the form will be routed for approval to the high school chosen by student.
- 4) See **Parent Guide** at www.broward.edu/dual.

*Once the form is approved by your parent/legal guardian, your form will be routed to the school you chose on your form for approval.

PARENTS: There is a guide to walk you through setting up your online account to approve your student's Dual Enrollment Recommendation Form. This guide is on the BC website by clicking on the student tile.

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Step 5: Your counselor will approve your Early Admission form or Dual Enrollment form. Then Broward College will approve your form and will send you an email that includes the number of credits you are allowed to take, the course choices your counselor has approved, and when you can begin registering for your course(s).

Also, you will have the option to view your completed form. **(Continuing students skip to step 7.)**

You may view your completed form at any time by visiting the [Dual Enrollment website](#). Once you click on the Dual Enrollment Recommendation form link, go to the **Forms History** menu under the **My Forms** option and click either the PDF or HTML view.

You may begin to register for your approved courses as listed above on the first day of registration. Please visit the [Academic Calendar](#) for the first day of registration.

As a reminder, if you choose courses that are not on your approved course(s) list, you will receive a registration error.

Step 7: STARTING May 27th, the first day you can register for your fall BC class(es), log into your [BC One](#)

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Step 8: Provide a copy of your fall Early Admission or Dual Enrollment schedule to Ms. Ziccardi.

Step 9: It is time to get your books! About three weeks before the term begins, books will be available to order online or you may go to the bookstore and pick up your books. Visit the [Bookstore website](#) for hours of operation.

Public and Charter School Students: You are not responsible for the cost of your textbooks. Follow these instructions on how to [order your books online](#).

Step 10 (if needed): If you are receiving any kind of disability services at your school, these services do not automatically transfer to BC when you become a student.
