SENIORS - Class of 2025- who are interested in having their study hall off-campus **must meet all of the following requirements**, as well as, turn in this form signed by student, parent, and administrator by Friday, February 2nd, 2024.

Qualifications:

- 3.5 weighted GPA
- In good standing with discipline (Must be signed off by administrator)
- Student must be on-track for graduation
- 10-10-10 Rule (No more than 10 Sign Outs, 10 Tardies, & 10 Absences in Junior Year)

Please note: At any point, your privilege can and will be revoked if you no longer meet any of the qualifications listed above. Also, student and parent must understand that the student needs to be provided with transportation to leave campus after 3rd / 7th period. Students with 2nd lunch MAY leave school at the beginning of B lunch period. In addition, students with an off-campus study hall are NOT permitted to stay on campus during their assigned off-campus study hall period. Lastly, students are required to attend several mandatory senior meetings that will be held during study hall periods. On those dates, students with senior privilege will remain on campus for those meetings and are responsible for all information covered in those meetings.
